THE PROJECT

Dober Lidsky Mathey has assisted the University of the Incarnate Word (UIW) over the past decade in the preparation of a wide range of campus planning, facility planning and facility programming studies.

CHALLENGE

UIW is the largest Catholic and the 4th largest private university in Texas. It ranks among the top schools for veterans and ranks No. 1 in the nation among faith-based universities graduating Hispanic students with bachelor's degrees. UIW operates campus distributed over multiple locations throughout the city with its main campus at the intersection of Broadway and Hildebrand north of downtown. It is a dynamic institution of over 6,000 students with particular strengths in the health sciences and a Division 1 athletics program. UIW also operates 2 campuses in Mexico and a study center in France.

SOLUTION

To date, DLM has prepared multiple studies to identify improvements to support the university's strategic planning:

- The One Word Campus Plan (2019)
- Space Planning for Founders Hall (2021)
- The One Word Campus Plan Addendum (2022)
- Broadway Campus Vacated Space Planning (2025)

Each study is rooted in institutional data, informed by the strategic plan and sensitive to the campus setting and community. The planning has engaged all those affected by its recommendations gathering input from hundreds of faculty, staff, students and UIW leaders.

In 2019, UIW acquired the 600K SF Founders Hall across Hildebrand from the Broadway Campus and has completed renovations of 1/3 of the building. As growth-oriented units occupy this new space, the space freed will be redeployed to other strategically important uses.
